**ADDENDUM**  
**TO THE PRICE LIST AND CONDITIONS FOR THE PROVISION OF SILOPOR**  
**SERVICES**  
**FOR THE 1ST HALF OF 2022**

As a result of the deteriorating international political situation, the cereal and oilseed market is experiencing major disruptions, not only as regards the continued rise in prices, but also the supply difficulties caused by the closure of Ukraine's ports.

In view of this situation, we have been asked to create conditions that favour the creation of longer-lasting stock, taking advantage of some import opportunities that may arise, even if the volume exceeds immediate requirements.

In response to this request, SILOPOR has decided to extend the period of free storage from 30 to 45 days, from this date, subject to the following conditions:

- a) The extension will be applied to all importers, both at the Trafaria Terminal and at the Beato Terminal;
- b) As usual, acceptance of vessels will be on a "first come, first served" basis and subject to availability of berth and storage space;
- c) As soon as international trade has returned to normal, SILOPOR will decide when the free storage period should revert back to 30 days.
